While the regime can always rely on its cadre of *apparatchiks*, it often must also reach out to councillors whose loyalty to the revolution is questionable. This shadowy counterrevolutionary group known as the "Mushy Middle" includes **Suzan Hall, Peter Milczyn, Mark Grimes, Anthony Perruzza, Maria Augimeri, Frances Nunziata, Frank Di Giorgio, Raymond Cho, Bill Saundercook, Cliff Jenkins and Paul Ainslie.**

THE POLITBURO

Our Most Glorious Leader's key lieutenants include **Shelley Carroll**, in charge of the People's Commissariat for Finance, and **Joe Pantalone**, Mr. Miller's deputy, who ruthlessly enforces party discipline. Both sit on what is known as Chairman Miller's executive committee, a body full of loyalists who've been elevated to the *nomenklatura* despite the revisionist tendencies of several members, including **Norm Kelly**, who is relied upon to control the unruly Far Eastern semi-autonomous region of Scarberia, **Gloria Lindsay Luby** of Etobicokestan, and aging revolutionary **Howard Moscoe**, who was relegated to the Commissariat for Tow Trucks and Graffiti Eradication after confessing to the crime of overzealous pursuit of socialist objectives.

Other members of the Politburo include **Giorgio Mammoliti, Joe Mihevc, Paula Fletcher, Janet Davis, Pam McConnell, Kyle Rae and Glenn De Baeremaeker.** Key loyalists among the masses of regular councillors include **Sandra Bussin, Gord Perks, Adrian Heaps and John Fillion**, who as health commissar has aggressively pursued the forced collectivization of hot-dog carts.
