TORY MEETS WITH COUNCILLORS TO DISCUSS OMB

Welcomes call for all-party effort to reform Ontario Municipal Board

(Queen's Park) – Progressive Conservative Party Leader John Tory today welcomed the opportunity to meet with five Toronto City Councillors and four representatives from the Federation of North Toronto Residents Associations to discuss Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) reform.

“This is yet another area where the McGuinty Liberals promised change but we’ve seen no signs of them keeping their promise,” said Tory. “I particularly welcome the group’s idea of an all-party effort to reform the OMB. I would be happy to participate in such an approach to this issue although that sort of thing seems to very rarely happen at Queen’s Park.”

Tory added: “Regardless of how the OMB is reformed, it is clear that we need consistent rules and procedures to be applied and followed by all parties for the benefit of the public interest.”
