1. Introductions:

- **Jennie Weller** started the meeting.
- Committee members and staff introduced themselves

2. Construction Updates a) work completed b) upcoming work

a. George Rozanski gave an update on work between Yonge St. and Avenue Rd.

- Street Car tracks one week ago
- North side of St. Clair, sidewalks done between Deer park and Yonge
- Will commence between Avenue and Deer Park next week
- This weekend is the last major intersection closure to rebuild the pavement on the south side.
- Southbound Avenue Traffic will close 10am Friday – traffic can go west or east on St. Clair. Northbound will close at 7pm, traffic can go east or

west on Davenport, rest of traffic will divert elsewhere. Lynwood will be last exit. Rest of the traffic will go North on Poplar Plains.

- Signs will be placed at Poplar Plains advising traffic of closure and that Poplar Plains is not a detour
- Traffic this weekend won't cause too much disruption
- Some work at Yonge will require curb lane closures outside of rush hour (3-4 days).
- Will finish paving and concrete by Dec 15th
- Electrical work and signals etc. to achieve street car resumption will continue till mid-February
- **Councillor Mihevc** requested a chart to update him on the progress made and upcoming work for all the pieces of work. **Howard Katz** asked for something in the 'chart' to ask about where traffic is constricted. **Pierre D'Aoust** requested that it be made available on the web-site
- **Councillor Mihevc** asked when street cars would be resumed west of Bathurst. **Scott Duggan** replied January
- **Councillor Mihevc** asked when the shelters would be up. **Scott Duggan** replied, early next year, mid-winter all hardware should be up, just not planters and art.

3. Traffic Management

- **Curt Russell** gave an update on traffic.
- The school on poplar plains has been dealt with; Al Pearson was also get a letter from the school
- They are still looking at the dedicated left turn lanes at Heath
- Looking for flaggers at Avenue and St. Clair- to help trucks enter and exit at construction site
- **Gian Sansalone** mentioned that there would be some traffic diverted onto the streetcar allowance, so there will be some weaving at Avenue, Deer Park and Young

4. Transit Service

- **Scott Duggan** said that diversions for this weekend have been posted and advertised.
- **Councillor Mihevc** asked if the bus service will continue to run above ground? **Scott Duggan** replied that the buses will be going back into the station in the next few weeks

5. Other Issues/Questions

- **Councillor Mihevc** asked if Concrete work would be done by Dec. 15th. **Gian Sansalone** replied that it was the target
- **Pierre D'Aoust** asked about the trees at the north east corner near the park. **George Rozanski** replied that the trees won't be taken down this year, but they will be taken down once the enhancement plans for Amsterdam Park are complete. They are trying to build curb and sidewalk to preserve trees, but those trees are losing a lot of roots. Arborist says trees won't make it. **Howard Katz** would like to see trees given a chance
- **Councillor Mihevc** asked if the buises would ru up the ROW . **Scott Duggan** replied, no – they will still be working on electrical.

- **Councillor Mihevc** said the priority should be get the tunnel and concrete done for Christmas shopping.
