Dear Ms. Solicitor;

At its meeting of April 16, 2002, Council at adopted a number of motions having to do with the proposed Minto development at 2195 Yonge Street.

Key among them was the requirement that you negotiate a "compromise proposal" prior to the scheduled Ontario Municipal Board hearing on this matter on May 27, 2002. The principles guiding such negotiation were also set out by Council.

I assume that you will call on other city staff for input on the complex planning matters before you. The purpose of this letter is to request that you involve me as the Ward Councillor as well, and provide me with both notice of and involvement in all meetings you have with the applicant in order to arrive at such a compromise proposal.

In addition, I would also like representatives of the umbrella resident association, FoNTRA, to have the same status as myself. The appropriate individual to contact is Jason Stewart, who can be reached at 416-485-3188.

As a final matter, I would appreciate you advising me whether any such compromise proposal is to be sent to Council for approval prior to it being forwarded to the Ontario Municipal Board.
