

NOTICE OF MOTION**RESTORE FUNDING TO ALL OUTDOOR ARTIFICIAL ICE RINKS****Moved by: Councillor Michael Walker** _____**Seconded by: Councillor Karen Stintz** _____**SUMMARY:**

Without seeking City Council authority, the City Manager has unilaterally implemented cost containment measures to find savings in the 2007 Approved Operating Budget to offset an anticipated shortfall in the 2008 Budget.

These cost containment measures include the closure of libraries, postponement of the opening of outdoor artificial ice rinks, reduction of the proper maintenance of our parks, cancellation of snow clearing, and so on.

As of September 26th, City Council has reversed the originally implemented closure of community centres on Mondays.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. City Council direct the City Manager to take immediate steps to restore the funding and operation of all outdoor artificial ice rinks as per the 2007 Approved Operating Budget.
