In your letter of June 28, 2007, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for speed humps on Taunton Road, between Soudan Avenue and Eglinton Avenue East.

Ballots were mailed out on July 16, 2007 with the last date for filing a response being August 14, 2007. The following is the poll result:

Actual Number of Returned Ballots	58
In Favour of Speed Humps	48
Opposed to Speed Humps	10
Mail Returned by Post Office	3
No Reply	51

I advise that speed humps can be approved pursuant to the City of Toronto Traffic Calming Policy, since a majority of the ballots received were in favour.
