– *Outcomes of December 11, 2003 Public Meeting*

Dear Mr. Budimirovic,

Further to a public meeting held December 11, 2003 regarding resident-generated proposals for traffic calming on Woodlawn Avenue West, I would like to summarize the residents' requests for further study. The meeting was a positive consultation and in my opinion, successful in showing a consensus for the further investigation of the installation of speed humps on Woodlawn Avenue West.

I request the following on behalf of the residents of Woodlawn Avenue West:

- 1) Please proceed to the next Community Council with the report on speed humps for the authorization for a formal poll of residents and please provide me with a diagram of the potential lay-out of the speed humps as soon as possible;
- 2) Paint "stop-bars" on the road at the "stop" signs for all directions of traffic at the intersections of "*little*" Woodlawn Avenue West and Farnham Avenue **and** at "*little*" Woodlawn Avenue West and Woodlawn Avenue West; and
- 3) Report on the specific pros and cons of physically narrowing the eastern end of Woodlawn Avenue West at Yonge Street particularly respecting the possibility of planting a tree and adding other street-scape modifiers.

I thank both you and Mr. Stephen Benjamin for your attendance and expert knowledge at last night's meeting at De La Salle College. I look forward to working with you in the future on this and other projects.
